A Scheme by Department of Women & Child Development, Government of NCT of Delhi.

Aim -

The aim of this scheme is to combat the menace of female foeticide, to restore the demographic sex ratio imbalance, to facilitate the birth of more girl children and to meet the felt needs of the women and girl children in Delhi.

Financial Assistance -

The Delhi government would pay Rs 10,000 to the girl child on her birth. Soon after the registration Delhi Government will open an account in a bank for the girl child and deposit Rs. 10,000/-

Also Rs. 5,000 would be deposited in the same account at different time intervals each time on her admission to class I, VI,

IX, when she passes class X and takes admission in class XII.

Eligibility Criteria

- Girl child must be born in Delhi and not before January 01, 2008. Girls born prior to this date can also avail the scheme on taking admission in class I, VI, IX, XII or on passing X in the year 2008 - 2009.
- Parent's annual income must not exceed Rs. 1 lakh.
- The applicant seeking benefit must be a bona fide resident of Delhi for at least three years preceding the date of the application.

To avail this scheme application must be submitted at the nearest Women & Child Development District office/ Anganwadi Centres / Select branches of State Bank of India.
